# SEA TURTLE

## Flow

The idea that a turtle is slow might make you think that flow isn't part of its life. It's essential, though. Especially for Sea Turtle.

Sea turtle migrates thousands of miles. The only way they can do this is to find flow and then go with it, not against it. They're strong. Their bodies are perfectly designed for long distance swimming and deep diving, but they let the ocean do work.

The turtles pictured above are doing just that.

These reptiles also flow by eating what is presented to them. Yes they hunt, but they can vary their diets to let them thrive for long lives and as they travel.

They also flow from sea to land, using both worlds to fill them. They're faster and more graceful in the ocean, but use the sand and sun to build warmth and their babies.

Sea Turtle is here today to remind you to let flow work for you. Stay warm, stay in the flow of your natural rhythms, do your part, but let the current help you. Trust flow. It's not an option.

## Unexpected Power

While other turtles use their shells for protection, Sea turtles don't.

Their protection and defense lies in their subtle power: being unexpected and underestimated. Sea Turtle seems calm and gentle but is powerful and quick in the right circumstances.

They don't have teeth, but - depending on the type - they can be herbivores, carnivores, or omnivores. Their jaws are strong. Their necks able to extend to let them bite hard. Their legs move fast and with great strength. Swimming away is a main defense for them.

Sea turtles don't have ears, but can hear vibrations.

They sleep underwater, stay underwater for hours, and deep dive, but love the sun.

They don't need to be with other turtles (except for mating) but they're totally cool with groups of turtles (bales). They'll hang out in bales for long periods of time.

These contrasts are part of their power. They don't hide but with a turtle you can assume there's more power and ability than you see at first glance.

### Home

Female turtles have a strong homing sense, returning to the same place year after year to lay eggs. Some Sea Turtles will lay clutches of eggs on the sand in large groups at the same time.

They have many babies: up to 100 eggs per season. Females lay eggs in the sand by the water and then leave them immediately to get back to the water.

Even water loving deep diving sea turtles love to sun themselves but the ocean is their home.

They hunt, dive, and migrate, but they always know where home is. They know how to get back and go back annually for their own inner needs. Do you?

### Steady

In some Native American traditions, like the Seneca-Iroquois, the turtle is Earth itself. In their history, the world was built on the back of a turtle. Turtle was so steady it was there to catch Sky Woman as she fell and gave her a place to build life on. That's a steady power.

Some turtles live for over 100 years.

Turtles are ancient. 220 million years on this Earth and still here. They're a steady and constant energy for the planet, the oceans, the universe itself.
